## **Art. 1. Description**

The Baja Aragón will be held in accordance with the provisions of the FIM International Sporting Code (and its Annexes), the FIM Baja World Cup regulations, the national sports regulations, these Supplementary Regulations and any other annex approved by the Competition Jury.

FIM Bajas World Cup scoring:

- FIM Bajas World Cup 450cc, for riders and manufacturers
- FIM Bajas World Cup - Quads, for riders
- FIM Bajas World Cup - Women, for riders
- FIM Bajas World Cup - Junior, for riders
- FIM Bajas World Cup - SSV (Driver & co-driver)
- FIM Bajas Trophy - Veterans.

Any issue that is not specified in the annexes or in these Supplementary Regulations is subject to the interpretation of the FIM International Jury.

The modifications, corrections and/or changes to these Supplementary Regulations will be announced only through numbered and dated supplements (published by the Organizer before the 1st meeting of the Jury).

In case of doubt in the interpretation of this Regulation, the one published in English will attest.

### **1.1. Place and dates of the event**

Octagon Esedos in collaboration with Moto Club Baja organizes the fifth round of the FIM Baja World Cup called "Baja Aragón 2023", registered in the FIM International Calendar.

The itinerary of the Rally, which starts from Teruel, will run entirely through the Community of Aragón.

## **Art. 3. Entries**

### **3.1. Opening and closing dates**

- Opening: Saturday, 13 of May , 10,00.
- Entry finish with bonus: Friday, 1 of July, 14,00.
- Closing: Thursady, 13 of July, 20,00.

### **3.2. Entry procedure**

Registration requests must be made through the website with the official registration form, indicating at least

- Full name, nationality, address, license number and category of the rider.
- The characteristics of the vehicle.
- Participants with a different nationality from Spanish, must have written an authorization from their respective Federation and attach it to the registration form.

The final entries, beside with the entry fees, must be in hands of the organization before 19:00 p.m. on July 13th.

### **3.3. Vehicles admitted and class**

The maximum number of entries that will be accepted is 200.

The following vehicles can participate:

- Category 1: Motorcycles under 450 cc 2 stroke and 4 stroke.
- Category 2: Quads. (3 wheel vehicle are forbidden)
- Category 3: SSV (driver & Codriver).
- Category 4: Women.
- Category 5: Junior .
- Category 6: Veterans.
- Category 7: Motorcycles with 450 cc or higher 2t and 4t. (only for the Open Baja Aragón).
- Category 8: Trail motorcycles between 600c.c and 950c.c. (only for the Open Baja Aragón). Look at annex 1.
- Category 9: Maxi Trail motorcycles over 950c.c. (only for the Open Baja Aragón). Look at annex 1.

All vehicles must be registered with the documentation and insurance, in accordance with current legislation. It is the rider's responsibility to comply with this issue.

### 3.7. Refunds

The Organizer will refund the registration fees, less a variable withholding, to those registered who cannot participate in the event due to "force majeure", subject to receipt of the cancellation request to the Organizer by certified mail. The refund will be:

- **75%** of the entry fee for the cancellation request received up to 60 days before the start of the administrative scrutineering.
- **50%** of the entry fee for the cancellation request received up to 30 days before the start of the administrative scrutineering.
- The cancellation request received less than 30 days before the beginning of the administrative scrutineering will not be entitled to a refund of any amount.

All entry fees will be refunded to competitors whose registration request has been denied by the Organizing Committee.

Competitors who have not been authorized to take the start due to non-conformity of their vehicle during the technical scrutineering or of any document during the administrative scrutineering, will not be entitled to a refund of the entry fee.

### **3.8. Rider admission conditions**

To register for the Baja World Cup, any rider of any nationality must be over 18 years of age and in possession of a FIM Baja World Cup rider license valid for the current year, issued by their National Federation. Likewise, you must be in possession of a driving license in accordance with the capacity of your motorcycle.

To register for the Open Baja Aragón, any rider must be over 18 years of age and be in possession of an RFME rider license, issued by the National Federation or by any other FMN accompanied by the start permission. Likewise, you must be in possession of a driving license in accordance with the capacity of your motorcycle.

For those riders who do not have an annual license, there is the possibility of obtaining the license only for the days of competition.

The rider who requests registration for the BAJA ARAGON assumes the risks that this event includes. The rider exempts the Organizer and its National Federation from any civil or criminal liability in case of damages or accidents that might occur during their participation in BAJA ARAGÓN.

## **Art. 4. Insurance**

**4.1.** The entry fee includes the insurance for the following risks:

- Compulsory to third parties liability under current Spanish regulations (Law 21/2007 of July 11)..
- The payment of those sums for which competitors may become civilly liable as a result of accidents or fires caused by vehicles taking part in the event, with the limits set by legislation.

**4.2.** In case of an accident, the rider or his representative must notify the Clerk of the Course in writing, as quickly as possible, and within a maximum period of 24 hours. In this declaration shall state the circumstances of the accident, as well as, the names and addresses of the witnesses.

**4.3.** Only the damages caused by the organizers and the titular riders are covered by the insurance policy contracted by the Organization. Damages that may be suffered by the drivers themselves or the participating vehicles are excluded..

**4.4.** Regardless of said Civil Liability insurance, the participants are free to contract on their own and for their coexistence the individual insurance they deem appropriate.

**4.5.** Assistance vehicles, even displaying specific plates provided by the Organization, will not be considered under any circumstances as vehicles participating in the event. Consequently, they are not covered by the insurance policy contracted by the Organization and remain the sole responsibility of their owners.

**4.6.** In case of an accident, the participating riders exclude the organizers of the event from any liability and waive any claim against them.

4.7. The insurance will take effect at the beginning of the administrative and technical verifications of the Rally and will end upon completion of any of the following deadlines, in any case whichever occurs later:

- In case of withdrawal from the event by the participant.
- Completion of the deadline for claims, appeals or hearings of the Jury of the event.
- At the end of the event.

## **Art. 5. Open Baja Aragón**

Along with the the FIM Baja World Cup, a trophy called Open Baja Aragón and the Raids TT Spanish Championship will be held.

For this Trophies will be valid the Sportng Code of the FIM together with the relevant appendices, the general prescriptons applicable to the counting events for the Baja World Cup, the national sporting regulations according to the FIM Regulations and this Supplementary Regulations, and any other regulation acknowledgement approved by FIM International Jury.

For riders in the Open Baja Aragón categories, the use of the safety device known as airbags is recommended.

### **5.1. Open Baja Aragón categories**

There is no Open Baja Aragón Trophy for the SSV category. The trophy is convened for the following categories:

- Category 1: Enduro. Motorcycles under 450 cc 2 stroke and 4 stroke.
- Category 2: Quads. (3 wheel vehicle are forbidden)
- Category 4: Women.
- Category 5: Junior .
- Category 6: Veterans.
- Category 7: Motorcycles with 450 cc or higher 2t and 4t. (only for the Open Baja Aragón).
- Category 8: Trail motorcycles between 600c.c and 950c.c. (only for the Open Baja Aragón). Look at annex 1.
- Category 9: Maxi Trail motorcycles over 950c.c. (only for the Open Baja Aragón). Look at annex 1.

## **Art. 6. Advertising**

6.1. Participants are allowed to freely place all types of advertising on their vehicle, as long as:

- Be authorized by the FIM regulations and the legislation of the country.
- Do not be contrary to morals and good customs.
- Do not invade the places reserved for race plates.

6.2. The spaces reserved by the Organizer for its advertsing and which cannot be rejected, will be published by means of an Annex.

6.3. The absence or misplacement of mandatory or optional advertising, if applicable, will entail a fine of 50% of the registration fees and in case of recidivism, the exclusion.

## **Art. 7. Identification and competition numbers**

7.1. In the administrative scrutineering, each participant will be given 3 plates with the participant number. The plates must be placed throughout the Rally on each side and on the front of the vehicle. The absence or misplacement of a competition number will entail a penalty equal to 10% of the entry fees. The absence or misplacement of at least 2 competition panels or plaques will result in exclusion.

7.2. The chassis may be marked at any time with the specific marks designated by the organizer.

## **Art. 8. Tyres**

In accordance with Art. 1.47 of the FIM Bajas Technical Rules.

## **Art. 9. Fuel**

In accordance with Art. 82.9 of 2023 FIM Bajas World Cup Regulations and 2023 FIM Fuel Regulations.

## **Art. 10. Administrative scrutineering**

### **10.1. Location**

The administrative scrutineering will take place in the "Palacio de Exposiciones y Congresos" of Teruel.

### **10.2. Schedule**

The administrative scrutineering will take place on Friday, July 21, from 08:00 to 13:00.

The call schedules for the Administrative scrutineering will be published by means of a supplement on the Official Notice Board and on the web page [www.bajaaragon.com](http://www.bajaaragon.com).

Each participant will receive a control card to be stamped at the time controls of the Administrative and Technical scrutineerings.

10.2.1. The following Time Controls will be installed:

TCV-1: At the entrance of the administrative scrutineering (according to the schedule established for each team communicated by Complement). A delay greater than 30' (30 minutes) in the T.C. will be sanctioned with €100.

**10.3. Documents to be presented**

Each participant must present the following valid personal documentation at the Administrative scrutineering:

Competitor in FIM Bajas World Cup

- 2023 FIM Bajas World Cup or World Rally Championship license.
- Driving license corresponding to the type and capacity of the vehicle used.
- Identity document of the participant or passport.

Competitor in Open Baja Aragón Trophy

- RFME homologated license.
- Driving license corresponding to the type and capacity of the vehicle used.
- Identity document of the participant or passport.

Vehicles:

- Property registration title or authorization from the owner.
- Technical sheet of the vehicle.
- vehicle insurance policy.

**Art. 11. Technical scrutineering**

**11.1. Location**

Technical scrutineering will be held in the parking of the "Palacio de Exposiciones y Congresos" of Teruel.

**11.2. Schedule**

The technical scrutineering will take place on Friday, July 21, 30 minutes after the Administrative scrutineering of each participant.

**11.3. Requirements needed**

Only vehicles that meet the following requirements should be presented at the technical scrutineering:

- Rally plates, competition numbers, and advertising must be placed in accordance with the advertising scheme.

- The GPS system provided by the Organizer duly installed in the vehicle.
- The participant will be responsible for the collection and return of the GPS system in perfect condition.
- For security reasons and in order to keep the participants under control throughout the development of the event, the use of a tracking system (GPS) is mandatory. The rental of the GPS system will be paid by the Organizer.

The pick-up system will be as follows:

In the Administrative scrutineering, each participant will be charged a deposit of €100, which will be refunded upon presentation of the receipt that will be given to the participant when they return the GPS system in perfect condition.

#### **11.4. Additional scrutineering**

Additional scrutineering may be made regarding the general condition of the vehicle, markings and safety equipment.

Any camera, support or modification to the helmet is not allowed, as well as, all external fuel tanks that are not duly approved by the manufacturer.

If the participant refuses to verify the verification, he will be excluded from the event.

#### **Art. 12. Briefing**

On Friday the 21st at 2:00 p.m. a Briefing will be held in Teruel. Attendance at the Briefing is mandatory for all riders who must sign on the attendance sheet. The non participation in the Briefing will result in a fine of 100 euros.

#### **Art. 13. Super Special Stage**

On Friday the 21st in the afternoon a prologue of 17,51 Km will be organized. The recognition of the Super Special / Prologue test is allowed. The prologue can be recognized on Friday, July 21, from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. Reconnaissance must be carried out only on foot or by bicycle.

#### **Art. 14. Starting list publication**

Schedule of publication of the lists and starting order: According to the Race Program.

#### **Art. 15. Use of the particular GPS and tracks delivery**

It is authorised to use a particular GPS. Every stage tracks, will be published on the official web site ([www.bajaaragon.com](http://www.bajaaragon.com)) at the same time as the publication of the "admitted riders' List", according to the program.

## Art. 16 Development of the Rally

The starts of the Selective Sections will be given manually by the commissary in accordance of the 2023 FIM Bajas World Cup Regulations.

### 16.1. Starting order

Starting order for the Super Special Stage:

1. "FIM Baja World Cup" motorcycles according to number.
2. Quads "FIM Baja World Cup" according to number.
3. Motorcycles "Open Baja Aragón" according to number.
4. Quads "Open Baja Aragón" according to number.
5. FIM Baja World Cup SSV.

The starting order for Stage 2 (SS1 and SS2):

1. Participating riders with motorcycles and quads in the FIM Baja World Cup and Open Baja Aragón according to the order of the absolute classification of the Qualifying Special Stage. In case of ex-aequo, priority will be given to the rider with the lower number.
2. The FIM Baja World Cup SSV riders will start behind the car class SSVs in order of the prologue standings. In case of ex-aequo, priority will be given to the rider with the lower number..

The starting order for Stage 3 (SS3)

3. Participating riders with motorcycles and quads in the FIM Baja World Cup and Open Baja Aragón according to the order of the absolute classification of stage 2. In case of ex-aequo, priority will be granted to the team that has obtained the fastest time of the first Selective Section.
4. The participants with SSV of the FIM Baja World Cup will start behind the SSV of the car category in order of classification of stage 2. In case of ex-aequo, priority will be granted to the team that has obtained the fastest time of the first Selective Sector.

The starting order will be according to the following intervals:

- Top 10 classifieds of the FIM Baja World Cup and Open Baja will go out every 2 minutes.
- The rest from minute to minute.
- The participants of the SSV category will go out from minute to minute.

These intervals can be modified depending on the number of registered in each category. Any delay in the start of the different stages will be penalized at the rate of one minute per minute of delay.

## 16.3. Maximum time allowed and times to be awarded

For each Selective Section there will be a maximum time allowed. Any rider who exceeds these times will be considered as arriving with the Control closed and will be penalized.

The maximum time allowed may be modified at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course in the case of unforeseen special circumstances (weather, modified distances of the stage, etc...).

The times that will be awarded will be those specified below:

#### 16.4 Time controls

The time controls (T.C.) will be operational from the start time of each participant until 30' after the theoretical arrival time of each one.

Time Controls will work electronically through Stella navigation devices. An annex will be published detailing the operation of the system.

In the event that a driver abandons or does not take the start in a selective sector, he will be able to take the start of the next one behind the last rider who has completed all the selective sectors. In this case, he will request a new time for entering the Time Control and a new time to start the Selective Section. In case that the rider does not request a new start time from the Clerk of the Course, he will be considered out of competition.

In order to enter the classification, it is mandatory to have completed the last selective sector of each stage.

#### 16.5 Mandatory stop controls within the Selective Sector

##### 1.-Intersection Control (I.C.):

At all intersections with a road open to traffic, intersection controls will be installed, some of them being crossing controls, communicated with the Race Direction and marked with panels as follows:

- Yellow "C.I." sign: Cross Road at 200 meters.
- Red "C.I." sign: Intersection Control
- Beige sign with three black stripes: End of zone.

Rider must pay attention to the Chief Post Control Marshal and/or Police, in case they could continue without having to stop.

Any infringement to this regulation at the control post may entail a penalty of up to exclusion at the discretion of the Jury.

#### **16.8. Total trip distance for motorcycles, quads and SSVs**

The Baja Aragón 2023 for motorcycles, quads and SSV is made up of a Super Special test, three selective sectors and three Stages:

- Stage 1 includes the prologue/Qualifying Special Stage
- Stage 2 includes 2 Selective Sections (SS1,SS2)
- Stage 3 includes 1 Selective Sector (SS3)
- Length of the prologue: 17,51 Km.
- Total length of the Selective Sectors: 537,33 Km.
- Total length of Link Sectors: 358,60 Km.
- Total Event Length: 895,93 Km.

#### **16.9. Official time**

The official time of the event will be the one retransmitted by official GPS on every T.C. start.

#### **16.10. Inspections**

The inspections of the Selective Sectors is totally prohibited. Possession of course notes or other data other than that provided by the organizer is not allowed. The penalty is at the discretion of the Jury of the test.

In order to help the participants, the Organization will indicate, by means of arrows and tapes, the crossings and danger zones of the route.

#### **Art. 17 Road Book**

For the following of the route, the only official document is the Road Book. Both the signage of the route and the GPX tracks are only supplementary information and no claim can be made against this information in the event of errors or omissions.

The follow-up of the Road Book will be controlled electronically.

The pass of the vehicle for each vignette in the Road Book will be recorded in the GPS and the number associated with this vignette in the Road Book will be displayed on the screen.

All competitors must go through all the vignettes in chronological order and in no case in the opposite direction of the route to validate a previously omitted vignette.

At the end of each stage, the GPS can be inspected to control the validation of the Road Book vignettes

In case of infraction, the competitor will be sanctioned with the following penalties:

- 1st. Infraction: for each vignette omitted: 1 minute.
- 2nd. Infraction: for each vignette omitted: 2 minutes.
- 3rd. Infraction: for each vignette omitted: 5 minutes.
- Additional infractions will be passed on to the Stewards who may impose a penalty up to and including disqualification.

## **Art. 18 Assistance and refueling**

### **18.1. Location**

The help of external assistance and refueling is only authorized in the places indicated and provided for by the Organization in the Road Book.

After the start of each Stage, and for those participants who need it, it is authorized to enter the Service Zone. Extra time is not included in this sector.

### **18.2. Access time for Assistance vehicles**

According to the schedule.

### **18.3. Operation of Assistance Zones**

For security reasons and for the best functioning of the Assistance Zones, only assistance vehicles carrying the plates supplied by the Organization will be allowed to enter them.

The manipulation or falsification of these plates will lead to the exclusion of the team to which these assistance vehicles belong, by decision of the Jury of the event.

The plates will be placed in a visible place on the front window of the vehicle. Each team will receive a free "service" badge.

The maximum authorized speed in the assistance zones is 30 km/h.

Towing, pushing (or any other means that allows a vehicle to be moved other than by the normal or mechanical operation of its engine) is not allowed, unless it is in order to bring a vehicle into the road or to clear the track or control zone, these actions will entail a penalty of 15 minutes.

#### **18.4. Service in Selective Section and link Sections**

Throughout the Rally, all repairs to a competitor vehicle must be carried out within a service park.

Only repairs that can be carried out by the rider or another competitor in the race with the means on board or by the means transported by any of them are authorized throughout the route. Any other outside help outside the authorized areas is not allowed and will be penalized with EXCLUSION by decision of the Jury .

The aerial monitoring of the event is prohibited, unless expressly authorized by the Organizing Committee and for whose fulfillment the Spanish Aeronautical Authority will issue the corresponding regulations..

#### **18.5. Refuelling**

In accordance to Art. 82.16.4 of the 2023 FIM Bajas World Cup Regulations. Each refueling in the course of a selective sector will be subject to neutralization. The duration of the neutralization for the refueling will be 10 minutes.

#### **Art. 19. Parc Fermé**

Vehicles will enter Parc Fermé from the end of stage 3 to the end of the claim period.

#### **Art. 20. Complants & suggestions**

Any claim may be submitted according to the requirements of the FIM Arbitration and Disciplinary Code.

Any claim may only refer to one matter and must be accompanied by the amount stipulated by the Disciplinary and Arbitration Code).

#### **Art. 21. Final Technical scrutineering**

Final Scrutineering may be carried out in accordance with the provisions of Art. 082.8.4 of Appendix 082 FIM Bajas World Cup.

At the discretion of the Jury of the event, these may be done after the end of the last Selective Sector and before the entrance of the Parc Fermé, adding a supplement of time to the corresponding Sector.

#### **Art. 22. Results**

The provisional general standings will be published on the Official Notice Board located in the Rally Office at the "Palacio de Exposiciones y Congresos" in Teruel.

### 23.1 Awards Ceremony (Podium)

The awards ceremony will take place according to the Schedule Program of the event, on the Podium - Teruel.

At the opening of the Parc Fermé arrival, the vehicles indicated below will be at the disposal of the Clerk of the Course to proceed to the presentation ceremony on the Podium:

- 1st classified Scratch MOTORCYCLES
- 1st classified Scratch QUADS

For these purposes, an escorted caravan will be organized to go from the Parc Fermé to the Podium.

Failure to be present at the awards ceremony (Podium Ceremony) of the members of the Teams entitled to them, will entail the loss of the same.

#### **Art. 24. Application and interpretation of the regulation**

**24.1.** The Clerk of the Course is responsible for the application of these Regulations and its provisions during the course of the event.

**24.2.** Any case not foreseen in the Regulations will be studied by the FIM International Jury, who is the only body endowed with sufficient power.

## Annex 1

### Technical regulation

To take part in this event, the vehicles must be documented and equipped in accordance with the provisions of the Highway Code and the FIM technical regulations, annex.

#### ▸ Enduro Motorcycles admitted. Category 1.

ADMITTED MOTORCYCLES. - Standard or improved 2T or 4T motorcycles whose maximum displacement is up to 450 cc that must be in accordance with the current Traffic Code and Regulations and be registered, being free in this category the preparation and modification of all the elements of the motorcycle, respecting the Traffic regulations and these Regulations in terms of sound levels and equipment of lighting.

Modification of the vehicle chassis is not allowed. The installation of supplementary gasoline tanks is allowed, which must be firmly anchored to the chassis in a fixed and permanent manner and connected to the motorcycle's general power system. The minimum expected autonomy must be 130 km + 10% for safety.

The assembly of a "Route Book Holder" is authorized and recommended, as well as any type of measuring device (Terra Trip or similar) that facilitates the pilot's development of the test.

#### ▸ Trail Motorcycles admitted. Category 8.

ADMITTED MOTORCYCLES. - Standard or improved motorcycles with a displacement between 600 cc and 950 cc, with a twin-cylinder engine and a tare weight of more than 185 kg according to the technical data sheet (dry weight), which must comply with the current Traffic Code and Regulations and be registered.

Modification of the vehicle chassis is not allowed, nor is the installation of additional fuel tanks.

The tires must be homologated in accordance with Art. 1.47 of the FIM Bajas Technical Rules Annex.

The minimum expected autonomy must be 130 km + 10% for safety.

The assembly of a "Route Book Holder" is authorized and recommended, as well as any type of measuring device (Terra Trip or similar) that facilitates the pilot's development of the event.

#### ▸ Maxitrail Motorcycles admitted. Category 9.

ADMITTED MOTORCYCLES. - Standard or improved motorcycles with a displacement of more than 950 cc, with a twin-cylinder engine and a tare weight of more than 200 kg according to the technical data sheet (dry weight), which must comply with the current Traffic Code and Regulations and be registered.

Modification of the vehicle chassis is not allowed, nor is the installation of additional fuel tanks.



The tires must be homologated in accordance with Art. 1.47 of the FIM Bajas Technical Rules Annex.

The minimum expected autonomy must be 130 km + 10% for safety.

The assembly of a "Route Book Holder" is authorized and recommended, as well as any type of measuring device (Terra Trip or similar) that facilitates the pilot's development of the event.

▸ **Quads admitted**

Quads normally equipped with two or four-stroke engines, with no cylinder capacity limit, the preparation of exhaust and silent engines being free in this category. In addition, the change of the damping elements, mounted on the same original anchors and the change of brake pads and discs, is allowed. The change of wheels and tires is allowed, even changing the original measurements. Modification of the vehicle chassis or reinforcement welding is not allowed. In any case, the external appearance of the quad must be the original, except for the elements mentioned, allowing the assembly of additional tanks, which must be firmly and permanently anchored to the chassis and connected to the general power supply system of the motorcycle. The installation of a current cut-off device from the quad to the pilot will be mandatory, which may well be an elastic band on the pilot's wrist.

All modifications must be in accordance with the Traffic regulations and these Regulations in terms of sound levels and lighting equipment.

▸ **SSV**

SSV are motor vehicles powered by a single engine, four wheels, two or four wheel drive, produced in series, steering system with a steering wheel controlled by the driver, with seats for driver and passenger, according to FIM technical regulations.

## Annex 2

### Trail/Maxitrail category safety

The organization reserves the right to neutralize those sections of the route that it considers dangerous, in order to guarantee the safety of the riders in this category. Sections with speed limits will also be used for the same purpose. These actions will be carried out through Stella devices.
